**Secretary:** The June Board meeting was held on Monday, June 4. A motion to approve the May 7 Board of Directors minutes was approved.

**Treasurer:** Financials were provided through April 30. The Treasurer's report and listed payments were approved.

**President:** EWI updates were sent and corporate weekly updates were received. Attended the Purely Social event at Hy-Vee to learn about the NuVal food system. Attended the YESS Garden training class.

**Vice President:** EWI communications were received. Met with Barbara Eslick to discuss the board for next year. Please send firm logos for new EWI banner. Sent information regarding LCAM to those who indicated they may or will attend. Early registration has been extended through June 30, 2012. Soft sticker is preferred for Pin Exchange. It's almost time for chapters to start developing their budgets for the 2012-13 year. Dates to remember: 2012 LCAM is September 13-15, 2012 in Dallas, Texas. President's Caucus starts September 11, 2012; incoming Vice President should attend. Webinar – Jeri Mae Rowley presents Leading with Emotional Intelligence on Thursday, June 14, 2012 – 2:00 P.M. (CDT). Webinar – Bev Kennedy presents Are You Suffering Death by Meeting? Chapter Parliamentary Procedure on Tuesday, June 26, 2012, 2:00 P.M. (CDT). Starting Thursday, May 10, 2012, Certificate of Completion for Professional Development Webinars to be awarded. Just complete the survey after the webinar and print the certificate.

**Sergeant-at-Arms:** As of May 29, 2012, the Des Moines Chapter of EWI consisted of 42 member firms, 53 representatives, 9 life members, 2 sustaining members, 0 transitional members. Present at the May 7 Chapter meeting were 32 member firms for 76% representation, 40 representatives for 77% attendance, 5 chapter life members, 2 sustaining members, 9 guests. **Program:** The July 2012 EWI meeting will be held at Iowa Credit Union League on Monday, July 9, at 1500 NW 118<sup>th</sup> St, Des Moines, IA 50325. The Board meeting will begin at 4:15 pm. The evening will begin with networking at 5:30 pm and dinner at 6:00 pm. A Firm Night presentation will follow at 6:45 pm, and the Chapter Business Meeting will complete the evening starting at 7:15 pm. The July menu, dinner expense and program were accepted with no objections.

**New Business:** EWI Corporate is conducting a newsletter contest. The top three newsletters will be recognized. There was discussion regarding joining a regional board forum beginning next year. Responsibilities for hosting and coordinating the forum would rotate among participating chapters. It was suggested that someone be appointed to the committee, possibly a past president. Barbara Eslick will participate in a conference call on the forum and will send the call information to Board members, if interested in participating. It was proposed that another option would be to form a forum consisting of the Des Moines, Kansas City, Omaha, and Minneapolis-area chapters. There have been approximately15 applicants submitted for the regular scholarship. There are also funds available this year for the Rita McGinnis scholarship. The recipient of the Rita McGinnis scholarship would also be determined by identifying qualities that Rita emulated. Kim Thomas will keep the Board updated on the process.

# FIRMS IN THE NEWS!

- Des Moines-based technology start-up eDossea Inc. is now a preferred **Delta Dental of Iowa** vendor. The start-up created a platform to streamline referred patient records online between general dentists and dental specialists. Through this endorsement, providers in Delta Dental's network will have access to a discount on eDossea's monthly service fee with no setup costs
- **RDG Planning & Design** and Mason City received the Public Improvement Project award for the design of the Federal Avenue Streetscape and Plaza in Mason City from Main Street Iowa during its 2012 award ceremony.
- The Greater Des Moines Convention and Visitors Bureau (GDMCVB) will host a marketing and media panel discussion on June 5 from 8:30 a.m. to noon at Foxboro Conference Center, 6165 N.W. 86th St. in Johnston.
